

# MS File Encryption

## Introduction

MS File Encryption is a program to encrypt/decrypt files or entire folders. It's a very light application that can make your life more secured and more reliable. It can encrypt any type of files.



## Usage

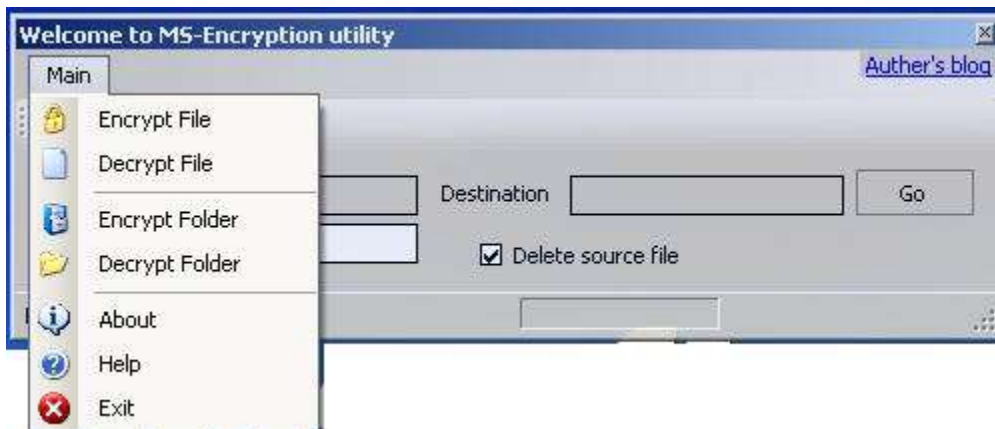
### Encrypt File

To encrypt file, you can use the menu and choose "Encrypt File" or the toolbar . This will open the open file dialog, choose the file required to be encrypted then press Ok.


From the main form, insert the password that you will use to encrypt the file then press "Go" button.

If you want the application to delete the source file after encrypting it, keep the check box "Delete Source File(s)". If you want to keep the source file, uncheck it.

The output file will be the same file name but with additional extension ".MSEnc" (i.e. if the source file is "myPasswords.txt", the output file will be "myPasswords.txt.MSEnc")



## Decrypt File


To encrypt file, you can use the menu and choose “Decrypt File” or the toolbar . This will open the open file dialog, choose the file required to be decrypted then press Ok.

From the main form, insert the password that you will use to decrypt the file then press “Go” button.

If you want the application to delete the source file after encrypting it, keep the check box “Delete Source File(s)”. If you want to keep the source file, uncheck it.

The output file will be the same file name but with removing the extension “.MSEnc” (i.e. if the source file is “myPasswords.txt.MSEnc”, the output file will be “myPasswords.txt”


## Encrypt Folder

To encrypt a folder, you can use the menu and choose “Encrypt Folder” or the toolbar . This will open the Folder browsing dialog, choose the folder that you want to encrypt its content and then press Ok.

If you want the application to delete the files in this folder after encrypting them, keep the check box “Delete Source File(s)”. If you want to keep the source file, uncheck it.

The output files will be created in the same folder with the same names but with adding the extension “.MSEnc”

## Decrypt Folder

To decrypt a folder, you can use the menu and choose “Decrypt Folder” or the toolbar . This will open the Folder browsing dialog, choose the folder that you want to decrypt its content and then press Ok.

If you want the application to delete the files in this folder after decrypting them, keep the check box “Delete Source File(s)”. If you want to keep the source file, uncheck it.

The output files will be created in the same folder with the same names but with removing the extension “.MSEnc”

## Working in background

If you clicked on the close window button (top right), the application will still be working in the background, you can use the notify icon in the system tray to continue doing any operation.



## Exit

To exit the program, either use the exit item in the main menu or use the exit item in the system tray icon's menu.
